




Czech Republic in general


- Personal approach to students more and more selective approach

- Using our e-application on muni.cz/en/admission
- Students need to provide:
 - Document certifying the completion of the school-leaving exam or of previous university studies
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Statement of purpose
 - TOEFL or Cambridge IELTS certificate (for non-native English speakers)
- Some faculties have written exam, some other criteria (essay, interview etc.)
- Preparation courses offered by Faculty of Medicine, language courses by the Language Centre
