Universal Learning Design and Accessibility of Masaryk University

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1.1. Mission of the Teiresias Centre

1. Central body of Masaryk University in Brno,

coordinates university's methodical activities, which ensure:

- a. its universal design for learning,
- b. individual adjustments for persons with special needs.
- 2. Provides **practical services** for the following target groups:
 - a. persons with special needs themselves,

(applicants, students, teachers, administrative staff),

- b. teachers, administrative and other staff who belong to the mainstream, but need to co-operate with the previously listed groups.
- 3. Functions as a methodical centre and service provider at the regional, national and international level.






1.3 Organisation chart






1.4.1. Students asking for individual adjustment




1.5. Key activities of the Teiresias Centre









3.1 More about the Universal Learning Design

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- targets the use of products, services and systems by as many people as possible without the need for adaptation;
- considers broad variety of users diversity of humans, specifically e.g.:
 - people with disabilities sensorial, motoric, on communication, etc.
 - neuro-cognitive disorders
 - ageing
 - people from different language and cultural contexts
 - users of various technological platforms

— ...

3.2. Applying Universal Design in practice

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Examples of Teiresias' activities on (co-)organizing

- presentations,
- conferences,
- lectures,
- workshops, etc.

in terms of *designing* the events for all.

3.3. Main targets group of participants

- deaf/Deaf, hard of hearing people
- blind, people with low vision

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- people whose native language differs from the main one

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- accessibility of (verbal) communication
- accessibility of (visual) documents

4.1. Accessibility of communication

- speech-to-text reporting (captioning)
 - now available at <u>www.text-on-tap.live/index.html#e=rurd-captions</u>
 - technologies used: Polygraf, Text on Top/Tap
- sign language interpreting
- personal perception of amplified audio via headphones or hearing aid (induction loop)

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4.2. Accessibility of documents (presentations)

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- presentation slides accessible on an individual mobile device
 - _ for users with low vision
 - to be enlarged, color-adjusted etc.
 - technology used: <u>Polygraf</u>
- digital presentation documents provided to participants in advance
 - _ for blind users
 - to be accessed by their own assistive technology on their devices

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
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5.1. Advisory Boards and Services

- advisory services and methodological support for ministry of education, schools, employers of disabled employees, assistive technologies users...
- advisory board for barrier-free Brno (City of Brno)
- governmental board for persons with disabilities (Government of the Czech Republic)
- expert panels and juries
- Association of Service Providers for University Students with Special Needs founded by Masaryk University

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5.2. Public Services

- accessible textbooks for schools (covering various disciplines (languages, history, <u>architecture</u>, <u>geography</u>, biology, mathematics, chemistry):
 - new production on demand:
 - digital books in accessible format
 - <u>tactile books</u> including tactile graphics (<u>2D</u> and <u>3D</u>)
 - library services:
 - <u>Daleth</u> national library gateway for visually impaired
- tactile maps on demand (<u>braille paper</u>, <u>microcapsule paper</u> or <u>plastic</u>): <u>hapticke.mapy.cz</u> (<u>bfmaps.org</u>)

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- <u>Pelion</u> educational gateway on assistive technologies
- <u>Dictio</u> sign language dictionary online

5.3. Commercial Services (B2B, B2C)

- accessibility assessment (web pages, electronic apps...)
- education, testing and instruction (DysTest, web accessibility, preparation of digital documents for blind users)
- sign language interpreting and translations, STTR/captioning
- development of assistive technology (BUF, Polygraf)
- tactile materials:
 - <u>orientation signage</u> (incl. labels for <u>elevator buttons</u>)
 - labels for exhibits (of plastic or other durable material)
 - orientation systems, haptic graphics, embossed prints, digital books in accessible format
- typical customers: museums, libraries, zoo, municipal authorities, public transport companies
